Dear Mercy Ministries Board Members:

Letters were sent to the board on May 8, 2009 and May 26, 2009 requesting certain information as to the operations and administration of Mercy Ministries, as well as confirmation of its current authorized representatives. As of this date, Wachovia Bank, Trustee of the Locke Little Trust has not received all of the information requested. We have not received the following documents:

- 1) Copy of Mercy Ministries Articles of Incorporation filed with the State of South Carolina
- 2) Copy of the By-Laws (currently in place) which establishes the operations and business practices for Mercy Ministries
- 3) Corporate Resolution establishing those individuals who may execute documents on behalf of Mercy Ministries

We did receive a notification from Safrona C. Finch on June 15, 2009 advising the Bank of her resignation from the Mercy Ministries board effective May 18, 2009.

Please note that ITEM XVI of the Will of Locke Little states the following:


"In the event Mercy Ministries, Inc. should cease to exist, fail to perform its ministries as set forth in its charter as granted by the State of South Carolina, or for any other valid reason for which my Trustee shall be the sole Judge thereof, then this trust shall forthwith terminate and the balance of the entire trust estate I give, devise and bequeath to the following and same shall be distributed by my Trustee to . . . [various other named charitable beneficiaries]"

Because we have not received adequate information from the Board, we have been unable to confirm that Mercy Ministries is "continuing to perform its ministries as set forth in its charter" as required by Item XVI of the Will. In light of this and due to the short duration of the trust, we believe it is prudent to temporarily suspend the income distributions to Mercy Ministries from the Locke Little Trust pending our receipt of sufficient information to determine whether an early termination is appropriate. Therefore, the net income transfer previously scheduled for 7/1/09 will not occur and the earnings will accumulate in the income category of the account until clarity is reached regarding the current status of Mercy Ministries.

Please also remember that the trust terminates by its terms on 1/1/10 regardless of the status of Mercy Ministries, at which time the balance of the trust assets is to be divided and distributed among several other named charitable beneficiaries.
